



**C. Places Site Consultants, Inc. – Rt. 56 Impact & Summary Letter  
Ed Kooyomjian Sr. & Jr.**

The District received a written impact and summary letter from PLACES Site Consultants, Inc. for the proposed commercial/residential project, Huntoon Memorial Hwy, Leicester. The site plans are for 48 2-bedroom units, 1 35-seat restaurant; 6,000 s.f. of retail space; 3,600 s.f. medical offices; and 7,000 s.f. of professional office space. All units would require an individual meter. Definitive plans are required along with the applicable fees and applications. Furthermore, CVRWD engineers would review the plans.

V. OPERATIONS

**A.** CVRWD has received a coliform violation on the samples collected July 18, 2007. Superintendent Knox received a telephone call a 6:45 PM, July 19, 2007 that the Henshaw Pond raw water, pump station, grindstone well, filter, CV standpipe #1 and 880 Pleasant St were unacceptable. The Greenville Standpipe and the Rochdale Fire Stations are unable to be read. Total coliform tests are conducted initially then a fecal coliform test is performed by the lab. The CVRWD staff chlorinated all the standpipes July 20, 2007. (7.5 lbs –G.S. and 3.5 lbs –CVS's). The same process was conducted on Monday, July 23, 2007. The lab was contacted for final results which indicated no fecal coliform. Additional tests were conducted and hand delivered to the lab today. There is a chance we may doing a direct mailing to the customers with the August 1, 2007 invoice.

CVRWD staff inspected all standpipes for vandalism and found nothing. Superintendent Knox noted that July has been warm and no hydrant flushing was performed. The heterotrophic plate count for June was great. We will watch the July count. If the July count is high – the algae and the lack of flushing would be a direct impact. The algae bloom in June was treated by Lycott Environmental.

Finally, additional chlorine will be added Tuesday, July 24 and Wednesday, July 25, 2007 as proactive measure.

**B. Rebuilding Filter I**

CVRWD is currently rebuilding Filter I. Morris construction is supplying five laborers.

**C. FY 2007 Audit**

The auditors began the FY 2007 audit today, July 23, 2007 and hope to wrap things up Tuesday, July 24, 2007.

**D. Leicester Highway Department**

Superintendent Knox informed the Board that he was notified by the Leicester Highway Department on Thursday, July 19, 2007 that they would be resurfacing: Atwood St, Atwood Lane, Folsom St., Bunker Hill, Lexington Ave, Pitcairn Ave and Route 56 (State funded). This required CVRWD staff to locate the gate valves and raise them as needed.

**D. M. Knox Vacation**

Overall things went very well while Superintendent Knox was away on vacation. The computer technicians came into check the alarms on the SCADA system and the exhaust fan in the filters had to be replaced at a cost of \$600.00. It was much more practical to replace the fan as opposed to repairing the vintage model.

**E. Inter – Chris Hamm**

The Worcester State graduate, Chris Hamm, has completed her internship with the CVR Water District. Chris reviewed the watershed area and developed a tool to assist the Leicester Police Department. A map and street listing will be kept in each cruiser as well as with the dispatcher. This will assist the police to readily identify the resource area. Chris also helped with the 2006 Consumer Confidence Report.

Superintendent Knox did indicate that he would be receptive to other interns.
